
## NEW HOSPICE CONNECTIONS



Three additional hospices have joined the HWE Shared Care Record:

- St Clare Hospice
- Garden House Hospice Care
- Isabel Hospice

Along with Peace Hospice Care and The Hospice of St Francis, this means information is now available from all hospices in Hertfordshire and West Essex ICS (NB: following the recent merger of Peace Hospice Care with Rennie Grove Hospice Care, we expect that information will also be available from Rennie Grove sites in the coming weeks).

## PAHT ENDOSCOPY REPORTS NOW AVAILABLE

Endoscopy reports have been added to the information available in the HWE Shared Care Record from The Princess Alexandra Hospital NHS Trust (PAHT). Endoscopy, colonoscopy, and bronchoscopy reports, completed **after 23rd March 2023**, will be available to open from the **Miscellaneous Reports** section of the HIE.

The availability of reports through the HWE Shared Care Record does not replace any existing forms of communication from the trust but does mean information is instantly available. Please remember that the responsibility for delivering results outcomes and treatment decisions remains with the professional who ordered the investigation.

## CHANGES TO THE INFORMATION AVAILABLE FROM THE LONDON CARE RECORD

Information from **University College London Hospitals NHS FT (UCLH)** is now available in the HIE as part of our connection to the [London Care Record](#).

**The Royal Marsden NHS FT** has suspended sharing for a period of several months while they implement a new electronic patient record system. Information that was previously available will no longer be visible until the connection is re-enabled.

As the London Care Record continues to grow we will continue to benefit from more information about our patients/service users who receive specialist care in the capital.
